

PROVIDER ALERT April 5, 2010

OMS Authorizations

Reminder: Concurrent OMS authorizations can be entered up to 100 days after the expiration date of a previous authorization. If a provider does not complete their concurrent OMS request within the 100 day window an error message will appear stating, "The previous OMS authorization for this consumer expired more than 100 days ago. Select Continue to proceed with an Initial request or Cancel to correct the OMS interview date." The provider must follow the directive in the error message in order to move forward.
