CLARIFICATION TO THE POST ENROLLMENT SITE VISIT DHMH PROVIDER ALERT

MARCH 22, 2016

On 3/11/16, a provider alert was disseminated explaining to behavioral health providers that the post-enrollment site visits were going to occur. This has led to some confusion that we are clarifying as follows:

Any moderate risk provider who enrolled as a new provider within the past four years will receive an unscheduled post-enrollment visit. Providers will <u>not</u> receive a personalized letter about the post-enrollment visits. Moderate risk providers include:

- Substance Use Disorder Programs
- Mental Health Therapy Groups
- Outpatient Mental Health Centers
- Psychiatric Rehabilitation Providers
- Mobile Treatment Providers

The letter that was attached does not apply to individual providers.

So What Happens Now?

Providers do **NOT** need to contact Medicaid nor Beacon Health Options regarding this process. The letter was sent out as a reminder of the required information that will be requested at the time of the site visit. This information is federally required under 42 CFR § 455.104.
