SUD UNINSURED AMBULATORY SERVICES UNINSURED PROCESS JANUARY 1, 2017 TRANSITION FROM GRANTS TO FEE-FOR-SERVICE

NOVEMBER 28, 2016

On July 1, 2016 eight jurisdiction moved from grants to fee for service. Effective January 1, 2017 all remaining jurisdictions will have grant funding for uninsured ambulatory Substance Use Disorder (SUD) services moved to fee for service. The eight jurisdictions moved on July 1, 2016 have completed this transition. The following Provider Alerts prepared by BHA and Beacon for the July 1, 2016 jurisdictions are being provided to assist those transitioning in January.
