RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER (SUD)

Attached you will find Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) concerning the new SUD residential treatment benefit for Maryland Medicaid consumers. This new benefit will be going into effect as of 7-1-17. Additional FAQs will be provided.

All providers interested in delivering this service must obtain license from OHCQ for the level of service(s) they wish to provide and enroll with Maryland Medicaid as a Provider Type 54. More information regarding becoming a residential SUD for adults provider can be found in the May 4, 2017 provider alert.
