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Important Note: If the age of the participant at time of diagnosis is *3 years old or younger* **and** it has been more than 2 years since the participant received the ASD diagnosis:

Clinical Confirmation Form (CCF) is required

Referral/prescription for ABA services completed by an above listed QHCP's dated within the past 6 months
