

MOM Case Management Services

Maryland Medicaid Program



Are you pregnant and struggling with opioid use? The MOM Program can connect you to all the care services needed for the health, wellbeing, treatment, and recovery of you and your baby. When you enroll, you will be matched with a case manager to receive support during pregnancy and your baby's first birthday. All services are free for eligible Medicaid members.

Are you eligible for the MOM Program?

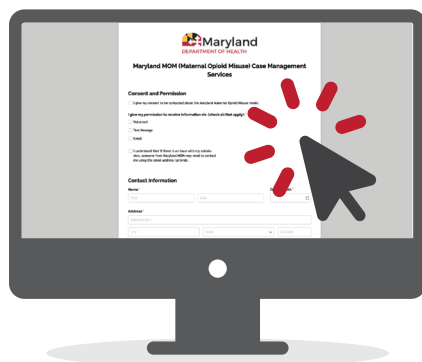
- Are you pregnant?
- Are you currently enrolled in Medicaid?
- Do you have opioid use disorder or have a history of using opioids?



How does MOM case management work?

You will meet with a case manager at least once a month and together you will come up with a care plan for you and your baby. That may include:

- Your mental and physical health needs
- Your treatment goals
- Basic healthy lifestyle needs and supports
- How to avoid overdose
- Medication for opioid treatment
- Other opioid treatments while pregnant
- Assistance with accessing local resources, such as WIC
