## Updated Fee Schedules for E&M Codes Effective January 1, 2021

June 4, 2021

## Target Audience: All Providers

We are advising providers that the posted <u>fee schedules</u> listed below have been updated with Evaluation and Management (E&M) rates that went into effect on January 1, 2021.

Specifically, please note that 99201 is no longer a billable code as of January 1, 2021. Claims that were submitted and paid, will be retracted (if not already) or providers can submit a void for each outstanding paid 99201 claim and submit a claim for a service corresponding to the appropriate E&M code.
