New Fee Schedules for Behavioral Health and ABA Providers Effective July 1, 2023

June 15, 2023

Target Audience: All Behavioral Health Providers

On July 1, 2023, Maryland Medicaid will increase certain behavioral health provider rates. Community-based behavioral health providers will receive a 3% rate increase. Optum Maryland has implemented the 3% rate updates for behavioral health, Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) providers and Health Homes for dates of service July 1, 2023 and forward.

Please note:

- E&M codes, laboratories, and J & Q codes are excluded from this legislative increase.
- Prices for Subutex and Zubsolv were updated based on current National Average Drug Acquisition Cost (NADAC) pricing
- Bunavail has been discontinued and removed from the fee schedule.
