Use of Single Incedo Login Credential by Multiple Individuals

Target Audience: All Incedo Users

Since Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) was activated for all Incedo users on April 27, 2024, it has been noted that a number of provider organizations are using a single Incedo login credential which is shared by multiple staff members.

Sharing one login between staff members presents a security risk to the provider organization and participant data. To comply with the MDH Information Security Policy, the State of Maryland Information Technology (IT) Security Manual, and [HIPAA regulations](#), which state; “*Under the Security Rule, covered entities, regardless of their size, are required, under § 164.312(a)(2)(i) to ‘assign a unique name and/or number for identifying and tracking user identity’*” **all users of the Incedo system must have their own, individual login credential, which is not shared with others.**

- If you need to enable individual users in Incedo, you should contact your system administrator to have individual accounts enabled. Instructions for adding users are given in the “[Managing Users in the Incedo Provider Portal](#)” training video.
- If a system administrator is leaving the organization, a new system administrator should be identified and set-up prior to the outgoing administrator leaving.

Providers who continue to share a single login credential between multiple staff members risk having their Incedo account deactivated.
