Increasing Access to COVID-19 Vaccines for Service Recipients within the PBHS: Lessons from Howard and Frederick Counties

As of October 18, 2021, Howard and Frederick Counties were among the top jurisdictions in Maryland with individuals 12 years of age and older served in the PBHS being fully vaccinated. The percentage of fully vaccinated individuals for Howard County is 59% and for Frederick County is 53%.

Learn how to expand COVID vaccine messaging and education, utilize existing infrastructure and operational protocols, and develop partnerships with community-based organizations to plan and to provide vaccination at mobile or pop-up clinics.
